APPRENTICESHIP GRADUATION



Please join us in celebrating the success of the 2024 Apprenticeship Graduation Class. The apprentices who completed their apprenticeship between January 1, 2024 – December 31, 2024, will be honored at the Local 364 Member and Turn Out Picnic on Saturday, April 26, 2025. Your family members are welcome to attend the event.

JOB OUTLOOK

29 Palms Marine Base barracks remodel, Xcel Mechanical - they should begin calling out in mid-April. Peak manpower will be eight (8) to twelve (12) fitters.

SBVCC, Thermal Air Inc – will need a welder with a UA-21 around the first week of April.

Desert Surf, Murray Co. – on and off site as of now but intend to start calling out by the end of April. Peak Manpower should be five (5) to six (6) fitters.

Perris Wellness Village, Murray Co. - will need two (2) to (3) plumbers “soon”. Control Air will continue to call out as the schedule allows.

Mountains Community Hospital (M.C.H.), ACCO - pre-con and investigation work starting in April, hope to start calling out in May for plumbers with a peak of seven (7) to ten (10). Project will also need two (2) to three (3) fitters by August.

Amazon Warehouse Hesperia, ACCO - starting underground at the end of March they plan on having six (6) plumbers on underground for approx. 1 month then take 2 months off and return to work after the walls are erected.

CARECA Tilt-up in Apple Valley, PV&C - started calling out this week. They should need one (1) to three (3) more plumbers as schedule allows.

Kaiser Riverside Tower, A.O. Reed – has thirty-two (32) pipefitters on site. They are 100% complete on the underground, work has ramped up on riser piping. They plan on hiring at the end of March and into April. Pan Pacific has thirty-nine (39) plumbers on site and will hire as needed.

Eisenhower Medical Center, Western Allied – will be doing a three-story Medical Office Building in June and should be needing eight (8) to ten (10) pipefitters.

Undergraduate Teaching and Learning Facility (UTLF), Murray Co. – job is held-up with engineering issues. They will hire as the issues are resolved and should need fifteen (15) to twenty (20) plumbers and about ten (10) pipefitters at peak.

Moreno Valley Compressor Station, Matrix NAC – will be holding a pre job conference at the end of April, we will get start dates and manpower projections at this meeting.

UA SCHOLARSHIP FUND



We are pleased to announce that the United Association Scholarship Trust Fund is gearing up for the 2025-2026 academic year scholarship awards. Up to 112 scholarships totaling \$502,000 will be awarded this year. Scholarships range from \$4,000 to \$7,500 each.
