JOB OUTLOOK

Ft. Irwin – ACCO is waiting on approvals for the existing hospital. They will call out five to six fitters and two welders.

Ft. Irwin Cogen Project – ACCO is still waiting on drawings. No projected start dates.

Indio Courthouse – ACCO is gaining ground, pouring concrete, and placing walls. Plans to man up in June.

Moreno Valley City Hall - ACCO was awarded the V.A.V. change outs. No projected start dates.

James Workman Middle School – ACCO will call four to five plumbers at the end of March.

Sunny Sands Elementary School – ACCO was awarded the project. The underground is projected to start in June.

Landau Elementary School – ACCO was awarded the project. The underground is projected to start in June.

Yasuda Building Renovation CSUSB – Xcel will call out two or three fitters and one fitter apprentice. Manpower calls were pushed back to late March.

SBCCD Crafton Hills Central Complex 2 Renovation – Xcel will call out two to three fitters and two to three plumbers very soon.

Refresco Beverages - Mazza Mechanical got their permits and plan on manning back up once a fire main has been relocated. They will need one foreman, one fitter apprentice, and one welder.

Ft Irwin Barracks Remodel - Rhew Plumbing amended to add more rooms therefore the requests for manpower were pushed out three to four weeks. They will need one welder, two fitters, two apprentices with a six-to-nine-month duration.

Ft Irwin JPL Project - Rhew Plumbing will need three plumbers and two plumber apprentices with the possibility of one or two fitters in four to six weeks with a six-to-twelve-month duration.

Barstow Defense Logistics Agency - Rhew Plumbing will need one plumber and one plumber apprentice to start in four weeks for a three-to-six-month duration.

Kaiser Riverside- A.O. Reed is doing underground with current manpower through August. They should begin to hire January 2024 for deck layout and inserts. They will start ramping up in February 2025 and will need thirty to thirty-five pipefitters for several months. The project will go to 4-10s next month and will remain that way for the remainder of the project. Project completion is scheduled for October 2025.

Kaiser Riverside- Pan Pacific is holding a crew of eight plumbers and will hold the crew size into the start of the tower and will ramp up to around thirty-five sometime near the end of the year.

UCR Student Housing- Murray has started underground and will bring on more as schedule permits. They should hire up to sixty plumbers by the middle of summer.

UCR Student Housing- Critchfield Mechanical should start hiring at the end of June and will need a crew of about thirty-five pipefitters to do VRF piping.

Inland Valley Hospital- Murray is currently running with fourteen journeyman plumbers and eighteen apprentices and will take on a few more in weeks to come.

Inland Valley Hospital- University Mechanical has a crew of seven journeymen and four apprentice pipefitters and is holding with the crew they have.

Casa Blanca Elementary School (RUSD PLA) - Empyrean Plumbing has one plumber apprentice on site and will be hiring a crew of four in late April.

Casa Blanca Elementary School - Valley Industrial is currently doing site work with a crew of two journeymen and one plumber apprentice. They will be hiring plumbers for the underground at the end of March.
